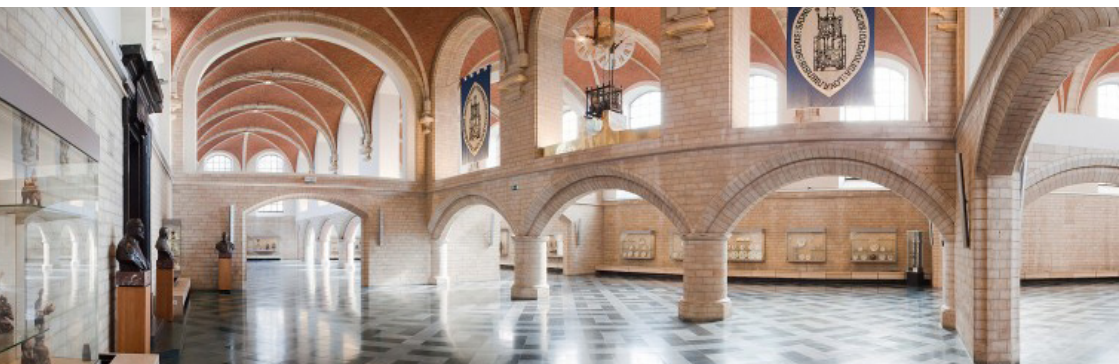

All topics in the area of rheumatologic research are welcomed. We would be pleased to receive proposals representing every field of our participants' interests.
